It is also worth mentioning that it might give you a set of chronic problems.

Having problems in your ears is similar to taking a leeway for your body to undergo critical disorders- not only for your listening, but also for your vertigo. Vestibular organs, placed in the inner part of your ears next to the cochlear duct, generalize your sense of balance, direction, and most of the sensory parts that allow you to feel your position precisely. (①) It functions similarly to a gyroscope you might find in your smartphones and smartwatches- tracking your positioning and inclination. (②) An example of the health problems you might face is vestibular neuronitis. It is a disease that is caused by nerves that connect the vestibular organs to the brain having trouble transmitting information due to infection caused by an unknown virus. (③) As the name of the disease states, it is a disease caused by ill nerves which is thankfully not infectious, although long-lasting. (④) Not only may it cause casual dizziness, but it can also lead to problems in dietary life such as frequent vomiting. (⑤) A majority of patients report feeling as if somebody was shaking their head back and forth every time they walked. These symptoms may last over two weeks, or even a month in some long lasting cases. According to medical professionals, this disease sometimes occurs in those who are in their thirties to their fifties, and is rarely found in teenagers.

Human beings have been acknowledged as rational agents that are capable of reasoning and learning of the observed. As a result, inferences drawn from a series of experiences were naturally made possible, slanted though they were.
